



CTV Variety Show Host

Description: Variety Show Hosts are responsible for creating entertainment content once a month, as well as hosting the variety show during scheduled times. Must have an interest and passion for broadcast journalism, entertainment, and community engagement.

Each show is expected to follow the CTV Mission Statement: *“Collegian Television strives to serve the CSU and Fort Collins community by training students to create content that not only entertains viewers, but informs them on current, local, and relevant information, events, and ideas.”*

An ideal candidate for this position has the following qualities:

- Interested in pursuing a career in broadcast journalism.
- Follows local and national news regularly and watches professional newscasts regularly.
- Possesses a strong grasp of video editing and writing skills.
- Understands the importance of working outside of business hours to respond to newsworthy events.
- Strong understanding of social media principles and ethics.
- Possesses strong communication skills and an ability to make decisions under pressure.
- Effectively balances time commitments outside of work.
- Responds to newsworthy events and prioritizes timeliness.
- Possesses a strong understanding of journalist ethics.

Main Responsibilities:

- Works with the Entertainment Director and show Producers to cover content and assign stories that are newsworthy and relevant to the student body and Fort Collins community.
- Works with the Social Media & Graphics Coordinator to create social media posts to tease the upcoming show.
- Attends weekly entertainment meetings led by the Entertainment Director and contributes story ideas.
- Films and edit packages, VO/SOTS, VOs and writes lead in/tags or readers for the story.
- Upload videos to the CTV YouTube and collegian.com in a timely manner.
- Attends the scheduled show, dressed in business attire, and hosts the entertainment segment.
- Communicates frequently with the Entertainment Director and show Producers about problems that could disrupt production.
- Volunteer for CTV when requested.
- Willing to help with community outreach projects throughout the semester.

Time Commitment: Must attend the scheduled show for 2 hours, as well as put in between 3-6 hours a month for filming and editing packages. Also, must be willing to volunteer 10 hours a semester. Overall, must be able to commit 8+ hours a month.

Compensation: The Executive Producer and the CEO of Rocky Mountain Student Media Corporation will negotiate compensation with the Variety Show Host. Compensation will be hourly and paid through RMSMC payroll.

To apply: Submit a cover letter, resume and any relevant video samples to ctv@collegian.com with the subject line: "CTV 2021-2022 Application: Variety Show Host - '*INSERT SPECIFIC SHOW*'" by noon on April 17th, 2021. Interviews will be scheduled and held by the Executive Producer between April 19th-23rd. Be prepared to answer questions regarding the attributes and responsibilities listed above.
