Description: The CTV Stylist is responsible for creating a clean and professional look for all on-air talent by providing makeup, as well as approving hair and wardrobe choices.

An ideal candidate for this position has the following qualities:

- Possesses excellent color perception and artistic ability.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work under pressure.
- Creative and detail-oriented.
- Desire to further learn about and hone talent as a makeup artist/wardrobe stylist.
- Previous experience with theatre and/or television makeup and wardrobe styling.

Main Responsibilities:

- Applies and reviews the make-up and wardrobe of on-air talent before each show Monday-Thursday.
- Maintains cleanliness and organization of make-up brushes and kit.
- Works with the Executive Producer to purchase the necessary makeup for various skin tones.
- Works with the on-air talent to achieve the desired makeup and wardrobe results.
- Reviews videos of past shows to create proper guidelines for wardrobe.
- Desire to learn more about professional makeup and wardrobe techniques for television.

Time Commitment: Must be able to attend every show from 5:45 p.m. until the run through ends, Monday through Thursday. Overall, must be able to commit 4+ hours a week.

Compensation: The Executive Producer and the CEO of Rocky Mountain Student Media Corporation will negotiate compensation with the Stylist. Compensation will be hourly and paid through RMSMC payroll.
